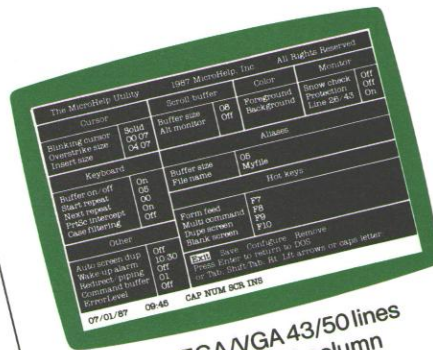

THE MicroHelp UTILITY

The MicroHelp Utility is an incredible combination of practical enhancements that save you time, trouble and money. All the little helpers you need in one small* resident program.

- **Increase data display speed** up to 300% and more. Your DOS displays will be so fast that you'll need our *true* Scroll Lock to slow them down.
- **Flickerless scrolling** on IBM and compatible Color Graphics Adapters.
- **System status on 26th screen line.** This is not a misprint—we mean line 26 for monochrome and Color Graphics Adapters. Shows the date, time and keyboard state. On EGA and Multisync monitors, status line is on line 25 or 43, or whatever the last line is on your monitor. Actually, we handle any number of columns and screen lines!
- **127 character keyboard buffer.** This feature can be turned off if you have other keyboard enhancer programs. Forget about the 15 character buffer in DOS!
- **Boost cursor speed and stop cursor "run-on".** You control how fast the cursor repeats. If you use "slow-cursor" programs like Lotus 1-2-3 and Microsoft Word, you're going to love this feature.
- **Enter multiple DOS commands on one input line.** You can even have them cancelled if the DOS errorlevel is set! No more having to wait while one command finishes before you enter another.
- **Use an "Alias" as shorthand.** You tell The MicroHelp Utility that when you enter "Oranges", it should translate it to "CD \Apples \Oranges" or whatever you want. Use up to 63K of aliases.
- **Select your own hot key** that sends a **form feed** to your printer most anytime.
- **Intercept Shift-PrtSc Key** when no printer is attached or when your printer is off line. No more Ctrl-Alt-Del when this happens.
- **Duplicate the contents of the active monitor on the inactive monitor** (if you have two monitors). Do this with either a selectable hot key or automatically (automatic duping not available if "snow checking" is needed on your CGA, but "hot key" duping is OK.)
- **Optional "filtering" of DOS input**—force upper or lower case for all characters entered at the DOS prompt.
- **A snap to install and learn.** All of the important features are configurable with an easy to use menu. Of course the menu has on-line, context sensitive **help**. If you prefer not to use the menu, you can change your features "on the fly".
- The MicroHelp Utility includes a **"wake up" alarm** that can be set and reset at any time.
- **Support** for Personal System/2, AT Enhanced Keyboards, EGA,VGA, Multisync, monochrome and CGA adaptors including 43/50 lines and 120/132 columns on EGA,VGA, and Multisync. Actually, it works with ANY number of lines and columns as long as the information is obtainable through the BIOS.
- **Lotus/Intel/Microsoft Expanded Memory** can be used for buffer storage. If you have Expanded Memory available, our program uses only about 10K of memory!
- **Full DOS command line editing.** Use the arrow keys, Ins, Del, Home and End exactly like you expect. Use Ctrl-Right and Ctrl-Left arrows to jump to the next word. Ctrl-End deletes the input from the cursor to the end of the input area.
- **Recall previously entered DOS commands** by pressing the Up Arrow. You control the size of the buffer that stores the commands (up to 60K).
- **Scrollback buffer** to view what has scrolled off the top of your screen. If you have two monitors, you can view the data on the inactive monitor.

- **True Scroll Lock** pauses your display. Press and HOLD the Scroll Lock key to pause, then RELEASE the Scroll Lock key to resume.
- **Can be removed from memory.** We don't mean "disabled" or "turned off"—we mean that the memory used by the program can be returned to DOS. But since we use as little as 10K, why would you want to?
- **Choose your own cursor sizes** in DOS and all programs that set the cursor via software. Allows you to set both overstrike and insert cursors. In DOS you can have a solid, non-blinking cursor. This even works on EGA's in modes that normally don't show a cursor.
- **Choose your own colors when in DOS.** This includes colors you didn't know were available on a Color Graphics Adapter! Like a Light Blue background.
- **Timed or selectable hot key screen blanking.** Save your monitors from "burn-in" and prevent others from viewing your confidential data. Works on monochrome, CGA, EGA, VGA, and Multisync monitors. If you have two monitors, both are protected.
- **Can be loaded in any order.** *The MicroHelp Utility* doesn't insist on being loaded first or last.

- **All features are customizable.** Use our easy configuration menu, with on-line, context sensitive help or change any feature on the DOS command line.

* The MicroHelp Utility uses about 10 Kbytes of RAM plus space for your DOS command buffer (minimum 1 Kbyte), Scrollback buffer (no minimum) and Alias buffer (no minimum). You control the buffer sizes to a maximum total of 64K. If LIM Expanded Memory is used, all buffers are stored there and only about 10K of DOS memory is used—otherwise a minimum of about 11K of RAM memory is used.
