





Speed you can measure. The letter-quality printer that taught you new meanings for the word patience probably crawls along at 12 to 50 characters per second. If you're lucky enough to own a "high-speed" dot-matrix impact printer, you've seen it jog off reports at somewhere around 150 characters per second.

HP LaserJet printers are rated at eight pages per minute (or about 400 characters per second).

In less than a minute you can

print a report that took anywhere from four to ten minutes on an impact printer.







Reproduced here courtesy of an illustrator's brush is the anatomy of a LaserJet 500 PLUS printer.

It's an easy way to show you how a laser printer works while pointing out some of the unique features that make our printers special.

First, a word about lasers. Using the principle that opposites attract, a high-intensity precisely-controlled light beam (the laser) is directed at a rotating mirror. The light is reflected onto a cylinder that changes polarity wherever the light hits it. These areas attract particles of toner.






