

#### **Level I: The Xerox 6010 Memorywriter**

# It'll make you forget how difficult simple typing can be

The 6010 Memorywriter puts together a long list of automatic features to speed you through a long list of everyday typing jobs.

**Automatic Correction** lets you delete up to a full line at a time, just by touching a button.

**Tabs, margins** and **line spacing** can be stored permanently for instant recall.

**Line** or **paragraph indents** can be set automatically.

**Boldface** emphasizes titles, headings, etc. while you type. This is the most popular automatic feature besides Automatic Correction – yet it's not found on some very well-known brands.

**CAPS LOCK** lets you type all capitals and numerals without shifting. Together with **Automatic Decimal Tabs**, CAPS LOCK makes typing tables and statistics much easier.

**Automatic paper insertion** means you simply place the paper in the platen, pull back the bail bar, and the 6010 automatically positions the page for typing.

**Low-sloping design** gives instant Print Point Visibility, so you can always see what you're typing. Lighted margin scales are right in front of you. A series of lights tells you what features are active.

**Keyboard touch** and **tactile feel** are designed for maximum comfort. The 6010 is much smaller than earlier electronics, and has the *lowest noise level* of any impact electronic typewriter.

**Daisywheel print quality** and thorough correction tape lift-off give all your work a clean, polished look.







#### **Level II: The Xerox 6015 Memorywriter**

# Play back stored phrases at 20 cps, instantly and error-free!

The 6015 simplifies the next level of typing by adding even more time-saving features than the 6010.

**15-character Display** and **Delayed Print** make it easy to change your mind or catch errors *before* they get on paper. "Prompts" in the display tell you what the 6015 is doing.

**Storage Memory** of about 3,000 characters lets you print out phrases or paragraphs error-free at 20 characters per second. Use the LIST TITLES key to display or print out the title and first 13 characters of each stored item.

**Automatically indent** lines or paragraphs on just the left margin, or both margins of a page.

**Auto Stop Codes** tell the 6015 to stop at predesignated points in a standard memo to allow varying information to be typed in.

**Columns** of varying-width numbers can be set up automatically, without manual positioning. Headings can be automatically centered over the columns. A *double underline* can automatically be added to any word or column.

**Dozens of typestyles** are available on easily inserted daisywheels. The 6015 automatically adjusts for 10, 12, 15 pitch and proportional spacing. Touch LINE SPACE to automatically set  $1, 1\frac{1}{2}, 2$  or 3 line spacing.

**Automatically align** text flush to the right margin, without counting characters.

**Touch END** to move instantly back to the typing point after making a correction, even on a previous line.

#### **Level III: The Xerox 6020 Memorywriter**

# This newest Memorywriter really lets you show off!

The 6020 specializes in saving time on medium-length documents that often need a certain amount of editing. In fact, for entry-level text editing, there just isn't a more automatic typewriter that produces such high-quality work, that's so easy to use and just as easy to afford. Compare it to *any* similarly priced electronic typewriter — and you'll see why Memorywriters have convinced hundreds of thousands of people in the few years since their introduction. When you compare, remember the real test of any feature is how easy and practical it is to use! Just claiming to have an "automatic" feature doesn't guarantee it's going to be helpful in your everyday typing — Memorywriter's features deliver time savings and productivity day in, day out.

The 6020's 3-Line Display lets you re-write your sentences to get them just right before a word gets on paper; proof your typing before mistakes get in print. The top line of the Display shows whether various features are in use or not. The 80-character middle line shows text and the cursor location. The third line shows plain-English messages and "prompts" that take you step-by-step through a variety of typing operations. This line also shows the input for "blind functions" such as centering, right flush, etc.

Document/Format Storage starts with 16K of "working" memory, which can be expanded to 32K or 64K with optional cartridges that install easily in seconds. So, you can choose just the right amount of memory to handle the documents you usually work with. You can store, recall and revise letters, reports, etc. with a minimum of retyping. Whatever you store can be printed out error-free at 20 cps or played back in the display for editing. Set up a format just once (margins, tabs, line spacing) and then use it over and over.

**Storage Cassettes** provide an inexpensive way to permanently store any number of documents. Simply transfer the contents of your "working" memory to these *optional* cassettes — each one can hold up to 64,000 characters. With Storage Cassettes, you can create an archive of stored documents, or keep confidential data outside of the "working" memory, or share a lengthy typing project among a group of 6020s. (Available 7/86.)

**The Automatic Spellcheck** option makes you a spelling champion! A 50,000-word dictionary automatically checks your spelling *and* also gives you up to four logical choices for the correct word. You can also create customized dictionaries of words relevant to your work but not contained in the 50,000-word dictionary.

**Block Editing** lets you Move, Copy or Delete blocks of text in a few seconds, with just a few keyboard commands. Up to 1,600 characters at a time can be edited, with the 6020 "prompting" you through each edit.

**The FIND Key** saves time by instantly moving you to the point where revisions have to be made. Just tell the 6020 the word or phrase you're looking for.


Forms Layout means you can fill in complex forms as fast as you type normal text. You just store the format of the form once; then recall it as often as needed. The 6020 will instantly move to each succeeding location where material must be filled in. Think of the time saved by not having to manually locate each fill-in area.

**Table Set-Up** avoids all the time-consuming work involved in aligning decimal points and centering columns and column headings. The 6020 *automatically* positions numbers and decimals, calculates equally spaced columns and centers headings over the columns. CAPS LOCK saves even more time by letting you type capitals and numerals *without shifting*.


**Right Margin Justification** is as easy as touching the JUSTIFY key.

Many more features, including format changes without carrier movements, printout of stored format settings, variable hammer intensity for stenciling, variable "hot zone" spacing, double spacing between sentences, automatic page end codes and lines-per-page settings, overstriking, GO TO END, automatic right flush, Superscript/Subscript, and LIST/PRINT TITLES. And, you also have virtually all the automatic features listed as standard on the 6010 and 6015, as well as a low-sloping design for better print-point visibility, comfortable keyboard touch and tactile feel, smaller size, and much lower noise level.

Removable disks hold up to 158,000 characters each, so you can store many short documents or a few lengthy ones on just one disk. When you play back a document, the 20-character display shows exactly what's stored. Move to any part of a document, do some editing, and thereby create a new document to store. You can completely change formats without re-typing; print out all or part of a document; insert variable data; move, copy or delete paragraphs or sections — all done with a minimum of effort. You can move text within a document or between two stored documents. You can copy an entire document before editing it, so you always have the original version on hand.

**Global Search and Replace** lets you make a change *once* and then have it done automatically throughout the document. So if Mr. Smythe is incorrectly called Mr. Smith in umpteen different places, the 630 searches for and replaces each mistake — and then tells you it's finished.


Forms Set-up lets you fill in form after form accurately and precisely, at the same speed as normal text typing. Store a form once and recall it as needed. The 630 automatically moves to each fill-in point, while the display even tells you what's needed at each point (NAME, TOTAL, SALES TAX, etc.). If there are repetitive entries, store them when you first store the form, and the 630 will print them automatically whenever you do that form.

**Page End Codes** automatically keep each page uniform and consistent by putting just the number of lines you want on a page.

LIST TITLES provides the number/title of each document, the stored settings for that document, the title and first 20 characters of each stored phrase, and the approximate amount of storage still left on a disk.

**Program disks** save more time by providing special capabilities with Document Assembly and Repetitive Letters.

**Many of the automatic features** of the 6020 are on the 630. That means you can productively use the 630 for *simpler* levels of typing.



#### **Level V: The Xerox 645S Memorywriter**

# Productive as a word processor, works like a typewriter

The 645S brings the automation and productivity of word processing to your everyday typing of letters, reports and the kinds of work that word processors and PCs can't do easily (things like multi-part forms, labels, index cards, envelopes, and jobs like tables and statistics).

**The 20-line Screen** gives you a big picture of what you're typing; so you see the context of your changes – and their effect – as you're making them. With Automatic Page Advance/Reverse, you can move in a few seconds to any page in a document, and make corrections or changes before they ever get on paper. Use the Display Control Keys to scroll through a document. Move, Copy or Delete blocks of text, up to 5,000 characters at a time.

**Editing** is simplified by a "window" that automatically opens up at the typing point. Two "Prompt" Lines provide messages and instructions that cover many different situations. Stored documents can be recalled to the screen at any time for further editing, or printed out—error-free at 20 cps.

**Automatic Spelicheck** is standard on the 645S. You can type faster and more relaxed, because Spellcheck will catch typos and misspellings, and bring them to your attention *after* you finish. Then, Spellcheck offers up to four logical alternatives for each mistake it catches.

**Optional software packages** expand your capabilities in Document Assembly and Repetitive Letters. Storage is virtually unlimited on 5 1/4" disks that hold 158,000 characters each.

**Communications Options** can turn your 6458 into a communicating terminal or receive-only printer, or open access to a network of Memory-writers and a variety of electronic network services.

#### **The Memorywriter Options**

A number of options are available for the various Memorywriter models. You can install most of them by yourself in a few minutes, and they can be ordered via the toll-free Xerox SupplyNet (1-800-822-2200), your Xerox Representative, or any Authorized Xerox Agent or Dealer. The Communications options on the 630 and 645S must be installed by one of our Service people, and cannot be ordered via the Xerox SupplyNet.

## Spellcheck: The Spelling Champion

This is a standard feature on the 645S. but optional on the 6010, 6015 and 6020. On the 6010 and 6015, Spellcheck will question a word that's not in its dictionary as you type. On the 6020 and 645S, Spellcheck will let you finish a document, then presents a series of options on words not found in its 50,000-word dictionary. You can 1) replace the word, 2) accept it as it is, 3) look at a number of words Spellcheck offers as the correct choice, or 4) add the word to a "custom" dictionary. A "custom" dictionary is compiled from the words, abbreviations, acronyms, etc. that are relevant to your work but aren't found in the main dictionary. On the 6010 and 6015, you can have one 500-word custom dictionary; on the 6020 and 645S, you can have several.

#### Type Right

This checks for correct spelling on our 605, 610, 615, 620, 625, 627 and 630. Memorywriters. Type Right provides a 100,000-word dictionary and a 1,000-word custom dictionary. It checks for proper prefixes, root words and suffixes as you type.

#### **Memory Expansion Cartridges**

These greatly increase the capacity of the 6020's "working" memory, so you can create and edit much longer documents, as well as store many more formats and frequently used phrases. The 6020 starts with 16K (approximately 16,000 characters) of memory. The two expansion cartridges hold an additional 16K or 48K of memory, to give you a "working" memory of 32K or 64K.

#### **Storage Cassettes**

With the 6020, these offer an inexpensive way to store any number of documents. Simply copy the contents of the "working" memory onto a tape cassette. When you want to work with that document again, transfer the tape back into the memory. Storage cassettes give you a back-up copy of important documents, provide security for confidential documents (by taking them out of the "working" memory), let you share a lengthy project among a group of 6020s, and help keep work separate by having different tapes for different people. Each cassette holds up to 64,000 characters. (Available 7/86.)

#### Communications

Memorywriters have another important advantage over "comparable" electronic typewriters: they can connect with other Memorywriters, word processors, computers, and even with networks in order to share information and work among widespread locations. Documents can be printed at one location, while another document is created at the same time at another location. The 6010 and 6015 can become dedicated printers or send/ receive terminals with a few keyboard commands. As send/receive terminals, they can be used for data base access, data modification and retrieval, order entry and many other applications.

The Communications option on the 6020 (available 12/86) lets it function as an RO printer and interactive terminal, but in addition, a built-in X-MODEM protocol opens up access to Ethernet networks and related electronic mail services. Remote access to the print, file and mail services of Xerox Network Systems is achieved via the Interactive Terminal Service.

ITS also allows for reliable file transfers between the 6020 and any communicating Xerox word processor. You can easily install the Communications module for the 6010, 6015 and 6020.

The same Communications capabilities of the 6020 are available with the 630 and 645S (as well as our 620, 625 and 627), but these modules must be installed by one of our Service personnel.

#### **One Source For Supplies**

In addition to the options described above, Xerox offers a complete selection of daisywheels, ribbons (including colors!), and lift-off and correction tapes. Actually, you can order all your typing and data processing supplies and related office products directly from Xerox or any Authorized Xerox Agent or Dealer. This gives you the built-in convenience and efficiency of ordering all your supplies from one source.


